| Year R | Pre-schools | We will invite children in from feeder pre-schools to share our grounds by picnicking, buddying up, staying to play and having fun on the field. |
| Year 1 and 2 | Care Home | Year 1 and 2 children will visit Oak Lodge the care home in Ashurst. The children will visit at different times of year including harvest, Christmas, Easter and Summer. They will sing, read, share cards, play games, garden and picnic with the residences. |
| Year 3 | Food Bank | The children will go to the Testwood Baptist Church to help will the food bank. They will collect items from their immediate community, sort the items and then compile hampers and bags. |
| Year 4 | Allotment | The children will support the Parrish Council by looking after the allotment area. |
| Year 5 | Parrish Council | The children will support the Parrish Council by serving tea and cake at meetings and participating in some of their clubs. |
| Year 6 | Community Leaders | Across the cohort, the children will be given a responsibility to uphold in their immediate environment e.g. house captains, play leaders (running activities for infant children at break and lunchtime), hosts (giving guided tours to visitors), PTA helpers (running stalls at events including setting up) etc. |
