



## **Foxhills Infant School Bookshop – Information for parents**

Each Wednesday afternoon, parent volunteers run a school bookshop. The children are encouraged to bring small amounts of money (20p - £1) into school weekly to save towards a book of their choice. Year 1 & 2 children start in September and reception children join in after half term.

Every child has their own savings card, which is updated with the amount of money they bring in (please ensure all money sent into school is in an envelope or purse clearly marked with your child's name and class). They visit the Bookshop with their teacher and class every other week on a rota basis, to choose a book which they can purchase once they have saved enough money. This encourages both a love for books and an appreciation of money and value, and we hope you will support your children's enjoyment of this opportunity.

On the Wednesdays your child is not due to visit Bookshop, their money will be collected from their class and entered onto their savings card - their book will be returned to their class that afternoon if sufficient money has been saved to pay for it. That way they don't have to wait until their next scheduled visit to take their book home.

The books range in price from 50p for a donated and lightly used book up to £3 for new books. There are fact and fiction books.

If, at any time, your child brings home a book that you feel is unsuitable for any reason, it may be exchanged the following week providing it is in 'as new' condition.
